

Researchers and publications per academic age group






He holds a PhD in sociology from Flinders University and undergraduate degrees in sociology and philosophy from the University of Ljubljana, Slovenia.

President Helen Bartlett, who joined USC in August 2020, stresses the importance of staying true to its mission.














QLD, as a region, has a high % of their researchers' publications being cited by Sustainable-Development-Goal-relevant Policy Documents – Can we learn more?
